Anyone who withholds information from, or falsifies information on this statement is guilty of falsification, a misdemeanor of the first degree. If the offender is an owner of a center or a licensee of a Type A Home, the conviction constitutes grounds for denial, revocation, or refusal to renew a child day care license application. If the offender is an employee of a center of Type A Home, or is a person eighteen years of age or older who reside in a Type A Home, and if the owner or licensee had knowledge of, and acquiesced in the commission of the offense, the conviction constitutes grounds for denial, revocation, or refusal to renew a child day care license application
