## \*HON 300 & ENQ HON

- HON 300 Honors Seminar I: Inquiry-Based Learning is required in the Fall semester for third-year Honors students with Junior status who have completed the majority of their Gen Ed courses.
- All Honors students must take an Honors section of Enduring Questions. ENQ HON serves as the Honors Enduring Questions course in the Spring semester of Junior year.

## \*\*HON Capstone Presentation

- The Honors Capstone Presentation should be designed to simultaneously fulfill departmental and Honors Program requirements. Students in majors that require a culminating senior project may use such projects to satisfy the Honors Capstone Presentation requirement.
- The project will be completed under the supervision of the capstone instructor in consultation with the Director of the Honors Program. Students with dual majors may complete their project under the supervision of either or both major capstone instructors.
- Individual Honors Capstones Projects vary, but the final product always includes a public presentation of the results in an academic, professional, or creative forum.

## \*\*\*Honors Sections of University Courses or Honors Contracted Courses

- Honors students should complete Honors credits through taking Honors sections of University courses. See chart to the right. Some departments also have Honors sections of major coursework.
- With the permission of & in consultation with the instructor, Honors students may also opt to complete an Honors Contract in a 300 or 400-level course. Honors students will find the form & guidelines on the Honors Student Canvas site. Students must earn a B- or better in an Honors contract courses.
