



Driver's License for International Students

The first step for getting a Driver's License in the US is taking the knowledge test, which consists on 40 questions of multiple choice (click [here](#) to find the closest test location from our campus). It is highly recommended to study and to practice with [simulation tests](#) before taking the actual exam. You do not need to schedule an appointment for the knowledge test.

For the Knowledge Test you will need:

I-20 Form

- The original and updated form.

Valid Passport

- Along with your old passport if it contains the valid F-1 Visa.

I-94 Form

- A printout of your electronic I-94 information, which can be obtained at <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/i94/>

Proof of Address

- Such as your [Social Security Card](#).

After passing your knowledge test, you will be able to purchase your Temporary Instruction Permit Identification Card (TIPIC), which allows you to drive with a licensed adult for up to 180 days. In order to purchase your TIPIC (\$25), you will go to the [closest BMV](#) and take all the documents listed above.
